- Inventory of water outlets used for drinking and cooking
 - Preschool Water Fountain
 - New Building Water Fountain
 - Alternative School Water Fountain
 - K/1 Water Fountain
 - Elementary Hallway Water Fountain
 - Elementary Office Water Fountain
 - Cafeteria Water Fountain
 - Outdoor Water Fountain
 - Boys Locker Room Water Fountain
 - Girls Locker Room Water Fountain
 - Kitchen - Two Sinks
 - Dishwasher
 - Concession Stand Sink
 - Ice Machine
 - High School Hallway Water Fountain #1
 - High School Hallway Water Fountain #2
- Plan for testing those outlets for lead and making the plan available to the public
 - Samples will be collected for testing.
 - Results will be posted in an easily readable format on the school social media and website.
 - Parents/Staff will be notified of any positive results within seven days.
 - Any drinking source that tests positive will be remedied and retested before access to that water source is approved.
- Provide information about the health effects of lead contamination to employees and parents of children at each school.

- Ensure prioritization of facilities that house early childhood education programs, kindergartens, and elementary schools. Those water sources are highlighted in the above list.
