Senate Bill 319 State Reading Requirements - Key Provisions

- * K 6 systematic assessment for identifying individual student reading level and problems and monitoring progress.
- * Reading Improvement Plans for students 4 6 substantially below grade level in reading.
- * Required summer school for students with Reading Improvement Plans.
- * Retention of students in grade 4 if they are reading below 3rd grade level (Sp. Ed. exceptions)

Yearly Student Assessment - Pre / Post & On-Going

- K 6 STAR test
- K 3 DRA test
- K 5 Benchmark Testing
- * Students At / Above Grade Level = Regular Program
- * Students More Than 1 Grade Level Below
 - 1. Individual Reading Improvement Plans for students more than 1 grade level below.
 - 2. Staff Professional Development on Reading Instruction.
 - 3. Parent conference with commitment to increase reading time outside of school.
 - 4. On-going parent information, education, and communication
 - 5. Tutoring
 - 6. Required Summer School
 - 7. Charting of Student Progress
 - 8. Post testing and evaluation of student progress
